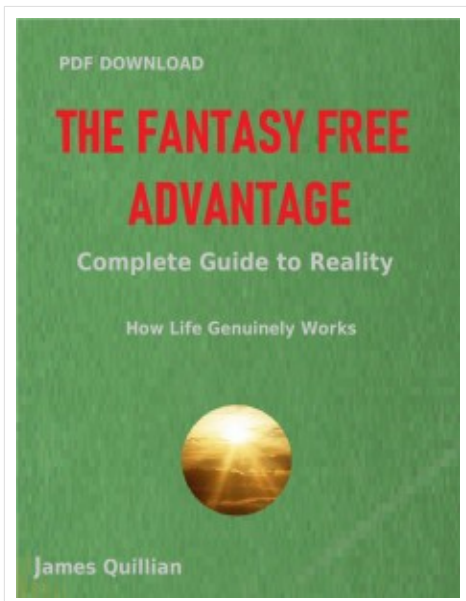




Robert Kennedy Jr's Vice President and his Chances
